Corazon Health Ltd, serving as both the Data Controller and Data Processor, is committed to protecting the rights of the individual and acknowledge that any personal data of yours that we handle will be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations 2018 (GDPR) and the current data protection legislation.

This notice applies to users of Corazon Health's website.

How we collect your data:

We collect your personal data when you visit our site, subscribe to our Newsletter to get the latest news and updates, interact with us via telephone or email, or when you fill out and send Contact Form to us. We will only collect your personal data in line with applicable laws.

We use a third-party provider, Wix, to deliver our newsletters. We gather statistics around email opening and clicks using industry standard technologies to help us monitor and improve our e-newsletters.

For all visitors to Corazon Health's website, we use Wix Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone.

Our website uses cookies. By browsing the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies. You may personalize your preferences and disable some of the cookies.

Cookies used on our website:

- Essential Cookies

These cookies enable core functionality such as security, verification of identity and network management. These cookies can't be disabled.

- Marketing Cookies

These cookies are used to track advertising effectiveness to provide a more relevant service and deliver better ads to suit your interests.

- Functional Cookies

These cookies collect data to remember choices users make to improve and give a more personalised experience.

- Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us to understand how visitors interact with our website, discover errors and provide a better overall analytics.

Types of data which may be collected:

The following data is collected, held and stored by Corazon Health and Wix when you fill out and send Contact Form:

- your name
- your email address
- your contact number
- the name of the company that you work for
- the way how you found Corazon's website
- your enquiry

The following data is collected, held and stored by Corazon Health and Wix when you subscribe to our Newsletter:

- your full name
- your e-mail address

Why we process your data:

- Data that you share with us by completing and sending Contact Form is used to contact you via e-mail or phone to answer your enquiry.
- Data that you share with us by signing up to our Newsletter is used to send you free e-mails with health & wellbeing news, updates, resources and other information that may be helpful to you.
- Data may also be used for audit or statistics purposes.

Sharing your data:

Your data is shared with Wix to send you the information you have chosen to receive. We will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to any other organisation unless we are required by law to do so.

How long we keep your data for:

In line with data protection principles, we only keep your data that you submit via Contact Form for as long as we need it for.

We will only hold your information for as long as you are subscribed to our Newsletter. You can unsubscribe at any time by clicking the unsubscribe link at the bottom of any of our emails.
